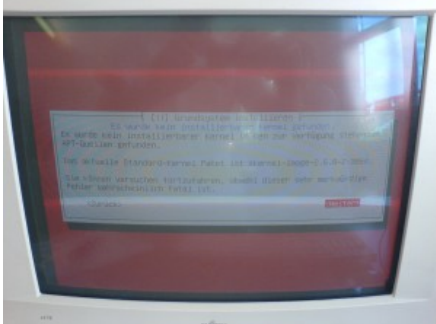


Fatal Error Or Not?

So what exactly was the point in asking me to continue when it aborts anyway?
